**We raised \$91,853 this year to help support our program services. Thank you so much. We couldn't do it without your help.**

**The board discussed and agreed that the financial impact that COVID-19 has had on our community has reduced our income from grants, event fundraising and general fundraising ability. We drew \$100,000 from funding set aside in prior years to fund a grant at Dana Farber Cancer Institute. We also provided funding for early lung cancer screening programs and have money set aside for our radon program. The board agreed to maintain a solid cash reserve to maintain programs through 2022. Cash reserves may be needed for COVID-19 emergency funding grants to hospitals and lung cancer patients. The release of funding will be discussed as events unfold throughout the year.**

**A board member attended several lung cancer research conferences throughout the year via video conferencing. Some of the meetings included International Association for the Study of Lung Cancer, American Society of Clinical Oncologist, LungSPORE, Maine Lung Cancer Coalition, and Genentech.**
