The board discussed and agreed that the financial impact of COVID-19 may reduce 2020 income from grants, event fundraising and general fundraising. The board agreed to maintain a solid cash reserve to maintain programs through 2022. Cash reserves may be needed for COVID-19 emergency funding grants to hospitals and from line caregivers.

Free ME from Lung Cancer has set aside \$15,000 for radon abatement program. We are working with the Community Action Program offices across the state to help identify single family homeowners that would benefit from our radon program. We also set aside \$10,000 for early lung cancer screening.
