We are happy to announce our continued collaboration with the many radon contractors in the state. The Normand Dubruiel Radon Air Abatement Grant is named after one of our board members who lost his battle to lung cancer. Our licensed contractor list is growing to accommodate the increased demand for a radon air system. We installed 5 radon air systems this year. One was for Maine Life House a nonprofit based in Central Maine providing residential housing for expectant mothers. Sheltering them through pregnancy and offering hope, support and life skills while raising their babies through the first year. We are working to expand our radon program in 2025.

We partnered with Central Maine Healthcare, Northern Light Eastern Medical Center, Northern Light Mercy Hospital and St. Josephs in our fundraising event. We matched funds they raised to support early lung cancer screening. We plan to reach other hospitals here in Maine in 2025 to support their early lung cancer screening program.

We signed a new contract with Dana Farber to fund additional research. The research began in late August. A progress report on Dr. Jia Luo's research along with an updated report from Dr. Julia Rotwo's research which can be found on our website.
